How we break down our comparison

To help ease your search we've broken down our research by core factors for comparison. These factors provide the background you need to quickly focus on the ERP solutions that make the most sense for your business.

Ideal for:

Is the provider suitable for your business industry? Whether that's ERP solutions for ecommerce retailers or manufacturers, this factor is important if you require a specialist ERP system.

Business size:

Whilst all providers will have their own definition of size, it's important to identify a company that's had experience with the unique problems of small, medium and enterprise level businesses.

Pricing:

ERP software is commonly priced in two ways: A perpetual license requires a one-time payment for your software licence, with the right to use the software indefinitely. A subscription model relates to a monthly or annual licensing fee.

Key features:

Whilst the scale and scope will vary from ERP provider, you can expect to see these basic features: Stock control, accounts, EPOS, manufacturing capabilities, customer management, and WMS (warehouse management software).

Implementation:

Will the training be tailored to your business through a dedicated team, or only accessible through self serve videos? How flexible can you be with users? Is there room for growth and scalability in the future?

Deployment:

How is the system deployed? An on-premise ERP system will mean the system runs on in-house servers at your own location, or at the very least, locations under your control. As the name suggests, cloud-based ERP systems are hosted on the vendor's server and accessed through a web browser.

Support:

Making sure your business can access help when required can be the difference between success and failure. In the best case scenario, your business won't need to have much contact with the support team of your ERP system, but should things go wrong, it's critical you have a provider to rely on.
